Nomination

The sending university nominates its student via email to the BUT's faculty coordinator. Once a nomination is received, the faculty coordinator confirms the nomination by e-mail directly to the nominated students, with all necessary information on how to apply (the nomination must include name and surname, study field, semester and email)

Nomination deadline

Winter semester / academic year: May 15
Summer semester: October 31

Application deadline

Winter semester / academic year: from March 31 to May 31
Summer semester: from September 15 to November 15




